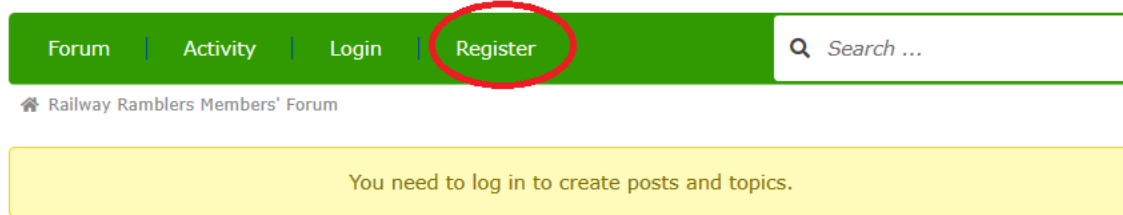


You will need to Register once to create your Username on the Message Board. Once you have Registered your details and set up your password you will only need to Login to use the Message Board in future (see Step 7).

1. To Register, click on the Register Button in the menu bar

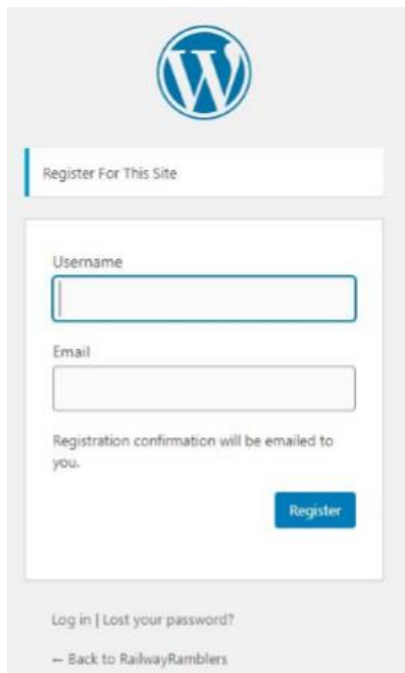

2. Tick the box and click the 'Continue' button if a Captcha page appears:

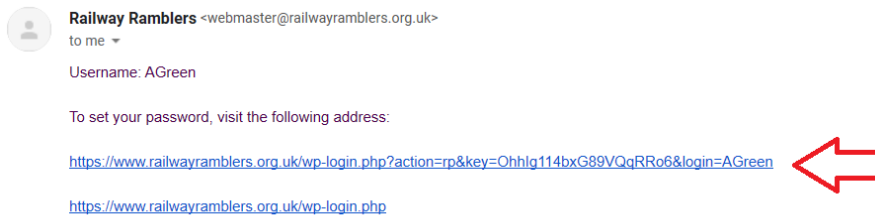


3. Enter your own Username and your Email Address. Then click the 'Register' button:

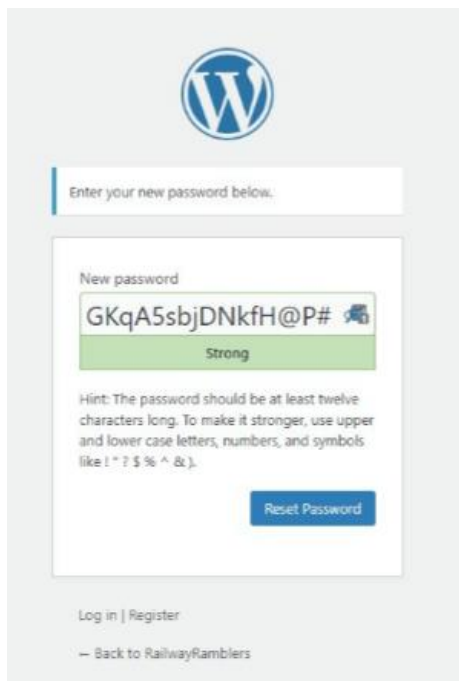


You will be sent an email from the RR Site to confirm your identity. The email shows your Username and a link back to the RR website where you will create a password and complete registration for the

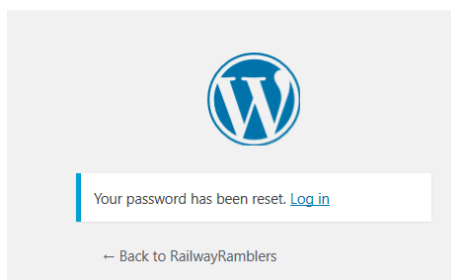
Message Board. Check your spam/junk folder – or Promotions tab (Gmail) for the email. The email contains these details. Click the first link to return to the RR website




4. You can choose the suggested New Password or set your own by over-typing the suggested New Password. Click the 'Reset Password' button to complete your Registration



5. Click the Log In option on the Password Confirmation Page



6. Enter your own Username and the password you have just created. This is the same Log In page you will see when you Login from the Message Board on all future occasions.
